# TICKETING

## TICKET PURCHASE

Beginning April 4, 2011 tickets may be purchased at [www.airrace.org](http://www.airrace.org). All phone orders through our office will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. We accept cashier's checks, personal checks, money orders, Visa and MasterCard for payment. Orders may take up to four weeks to process and will be mailed beginning in July. We ticket the "Best Available" seat.

**NOTE:** Internet orders preferred. After August 1, 2011, tickets are sold only through [www.airrace.org](http://www.airrace.org) or at the main gate during the event.

**TICKET BOOTHS** Race week on-site Ticket Booths are open on Monday and Tuesday, September 12-13, 2011 from 8 am - 5 pm. Wednesday - Sunday from 7 am - 4 pm.

## GENERAL ADMISSION

Ticket includes General Admission seating, access to military static display and the concession area. General Admission does not guarantee a seat. Prices from \$10 on Wednesday to \$27 on Sunday or \$75 for a season pass if purchased on-line or in advance, \$2 more daily if purchased at the gate. Senior and Military discounts available each day.

## RESERVED SEATING

Guarantee yourself a seat, reserve today! Ticket includes Reserved seating, access to military static display and the concession area. Prices range from \$11 on Wednesday to \$40 on Sunday or \$110 for a season pass, good for all five days, if purchased on-line or in advance, \$2 more daily if purchased at the gate.

## BOX SEATING

To purchase call (775) 972-6663. Enjoy the Races from your private box on the flight line. Package includes admission with 10 seats, 10 daily pit passes and box seat parking, good for all five days. Cost \$3,150 to \$3,300. Boxes can be expanded for an additional fee to hold up to 15 people. *Call for additional information.*

## PIT PASSES

Join the pilots and crews on the ground and see the planes up close. Children seven and under are free, children 8-15 are priced as juniors. All children's tickets must be purchased with an adult ticket. Pit pass does not include admission and must be purchased in addition to a General Admission or Reserved Ticket to access pit area. Pit passes range from \$7 on Monday to \$30 on Sunday or \$100 for a season pass, good for Wednesday through Sunday.

## HIGH G RIDGE CLUB

Ticket includes an afternoon at the High G Ridge Club, snacks, beverages and a High G Ridge t-shirt. Ticket does not include admission and must be purchased in addition to a General Admission or Reserved Ticket to access High G Ridge Club. Grand stand viewing on the edge of the Unlimited Course between pylon 5 and 6. Cost \$100 or \$90 for RARA members. (Limited to the first 100 people). Thursday - Sunday. To reserve tickets call (775) 972-6663.

# PARKING

## RV - RESERVED/OVERNIGHT PARKING

To reserve call (775) 972-6663. Limited dry RV parking is available at Reno Stead Airport. All RVs must be self-contained. No hook-ups available. Reserved Overnight RV parking per week is \$175 - \$300. "On-site" RV parking will require proof of ticket purchase.

## CLOSE-IN RESERVED PARKING

Located within the main entrance area and good for all five days. Reserved parking is available daily: Wednesday through Thursday \$20, Friday through Sunday \$25 and Season (Wednesday through Sunday) \$100. No overnight parking.

## HANDICAP SERVICES

For more information, call (775) 972-6663. A special parking lot is available with shuttle service to the front gate and to the main grandstand. Cost per day is \$10 and a season pass is \$50.

## CHAIRMAN'S HOSPITALITY TENT

Join race pilots, aerobatic performers, military guests and other VIPs for delicious food and drink in the NCAR's exclusive chalet. The Chairman's Tent prices and amenities do not include race admission. Race tickets must be purchased separately. Daily admission purchased in advance is \$100. Cost is \$125 at the door if space is available. Season pass is \$400 per person. A special Corporate Boxholder Package, priced at \$3,600, includes 10 passes when purchased in conjunction with box seating. Opens at 10 am. Thursday through Sunday.

## CHECKERED FLAG CLUB

New CFC membership includes a checkered flag club jacket as well as the returning member benefits of a hat, pin, poster, program, season general admission, season pit pass, access to the CFC grandstand, CFC parking and your own private hangar during the Races. Aviation-oriented speakers are scheduled each day, and a continental breakfast, lunch and beverages are served daily. A dinner on Saturday night is also included. Cost is \$800 for returning members or \$1,000 for new members. Daily member guest pass is \$200 per person. Wednesday through Sunday.
